"(q) PROHIBITION OF OIL AND GAS LEASING IN 1 2 ARCTIC AREAS OF THE OUTER CONTINENTAL SHELF.— 3 "(1) DEFINITION OF ARCTIC.—In this sub-4 section, the term 'Arctic' has the meaning given the 5 term in section 112 of the Arctic Research and Pol-6 icy Act of 1984 (15 U.S.C. 4111). "(2) PROHIBITION.—Notwithstanding any other 7 provision of this Act or any other law, the Secretary 8 9 of the Interior shall not issue or extend a lease or 10 any other authorization for the exploration, develop-11 ment, or production of oil, natural gas, or any other 12 mineral on Arctic areas of the outer Continental Shelf.". 13
